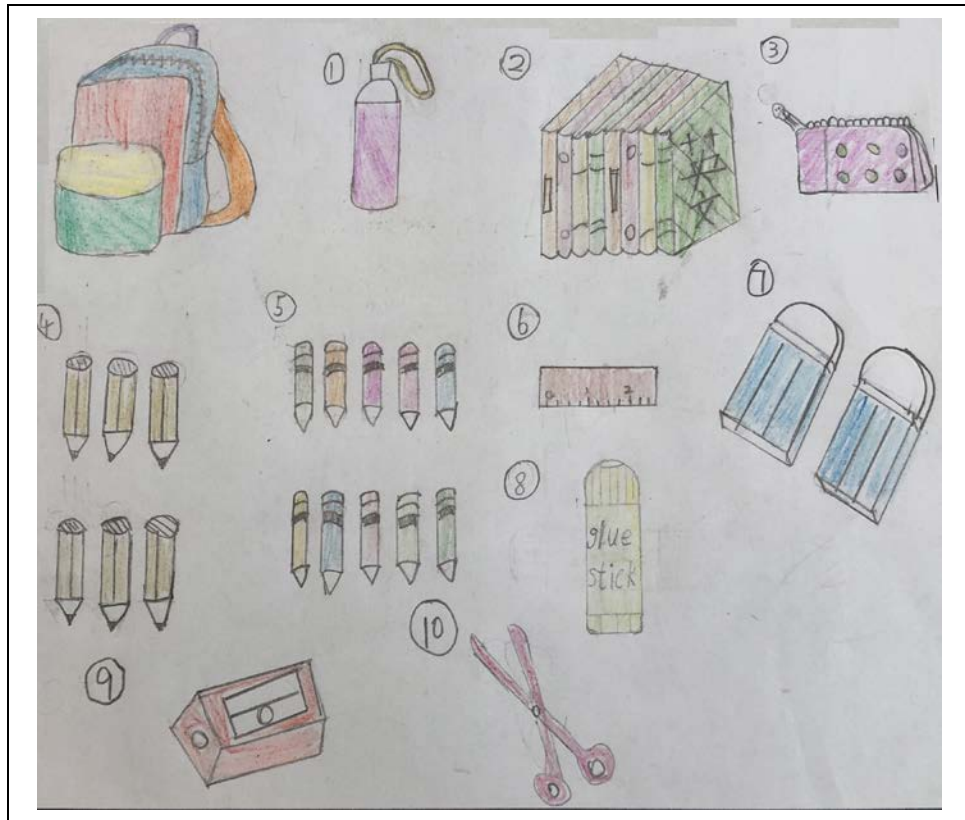

At last, the competition organizer told us that we were the first team back. In this event, I learnt about the importance of team spirit. I hope I will participate in this kind of event next time.

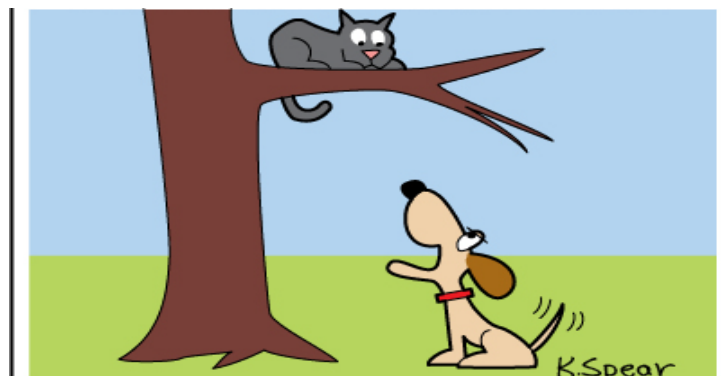
Be Nice To Others
